### Lt. Col. Steven Jeffery (United Kingdom)

*Consultant Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeon, Queen Elizabeth Hospital/University Hospitals Birmingham and Birmingham Children's Hospital, Birmingham, UK*

Lt. Col. Jeffery pioneered the use of Negative Pressure Wound Therapy to treat wounded soldiers both at the Field Hospital in Camp Bastion, Afghanistan and in the Queen Elizabeth Hospital, Birmingham.

Lt. Col. Jeffery will present his strategies for managing complex wounds including infection management and wound bed preparation in some of the most challenging acute wounds.

### Prof. Robert Burrell (Canada)

*Professor and Chair, Biomedical Engineering, Faculty of Medicine, University of Alberta Chair in Nanostructured Biomaterials, Canadian Research Council*

Prof. Burrell is a biomedical engineer with a long history of product design in the field of medicine.

In 1995, he made an important breakthrough in dressing design using nanocrystalline silver technology (ACTICOAT<sup>®</sup>), one of the most significant advances in woundcare history.

Prof. Burrell has been awarded the World Union of Wound Healing Society Lifetime Achievement Award for recognition of contributions to wound healing around the world.
